

Wootton Bassett Methodist Church Youth Club Rules

For Health and Safety reasons, on arriving at the club you must ensure your attendance is marked on the register, and all emergency contact details are correct.

We want the club to be enjoyable for all members and leaders, you are therefore reminded what Jesus said,

“Love your neighbour as you love yourself.”

which means:

- Behaving in a sensible manner
- Acting in a courteous way towards other members and leaders
- Treating the church buildings and equipment with respect
- Keeping the premises (inside and out) tidy – use the bins provided
- Avoiding the excessive use of mobile phones during activities
- Not leaving the premises during youth club sessions without the permission of the leaders
- Complying with the leaders instructions

There are also “House Rules” that apply to all parties using the church and the hillside hall premises, which are:

- No swearing
- No alcohol or tobacco.
- No disturbing the neighbours before, during or after use.

The breaking of these rules in a wilful or persistent manner will, at the discretion of the leaders, result in the offenders being requested to leave the Youth Club for that session - with the possibility of an additional ban of one or two weeks depending on the seriousness of what has taken place.
